

By-Law 48

A By-Law relating to the prevention and extinguishments of fires in the Village of Petiscodiac.

The council of the Municipality of Petiscodiac under the authority vested in it by section 109 of the Municipalities Act, being Chapter M-22 revised statutes of New Brunswick 1973 and amendments thereto hereby enact as follows:

1. In this By-Law
 - a) fire chief means the Chief of the Fire Department of the Village of Petiscodiac or his designate.
 - b) Open air means any open place, yard, field, or construction area.

2. The lighting of any open fire to dispose of dry grass, brush, hay, straw, leaves, buildings, construction materials, automobile or garbage in the municipality is prohibited.

3. Other than in a properly constructed incinerator approved by the Department of Environment and Local Government and its successors, no person shall light a fire outside a building for the purpose of disposing of any refuse or waste material.

4. No person shall set a fire that is likely to cause inconvenience or discomfort to others.


5. No person shall burn on the pavement or road allowance, which would interfere with traffic.

6. The Fire Chief or his designate reserves the right to order any open-air fires to be extinguished.


7. This By-Law does not apply in relation to live or training fires conducted by the Village of Petitcodiac Fire Department.
